Topic – Art

Dear Parents/Carers,

English	<p>This week the children will be writing and publishing their explanation texts on Volcanoes. They will also be completing their end of year reading assessments.</p> <p>This week is our last week of spellings.</p>
Maths	<p>This week in Maths the children will be revising their learning on 'Statistics.' They will be solving comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in a range of graphical presentations including bar charts, tables and line graphs. The children will be collecting data on temperature and then presenting this in a line graph.</p> <p>Mrs Thomas' class have done their last cracking times tables. This week will be Miss Reynolds' last cracking times tables.</p>
Topic	<p>In RE, the children will continue to learn about a variety of religious pilgrimages.</p> <p>For the rest of the school, Friday is 'move up day,' when the children have the opportunity to spend the day with their new teachers. However, the year four children will instead be taking part in a 'Soundscape Arts Project.' This will include building a den that can be used as a relaxation space and composing music and sounds that can be played into this space.</p> <p>We are very conscious that whilst we already know the children and them us, some of the children may still have anxieties about moving into year five. Although we do not have an official move up day, we will be working through several transitional activities over the course of the next two weeks. We would like to share with the children some of the exciting learning opportunities that they can expect in year five and will be asking for the children's input on what they would like to be focussing on.</p>
