

The Heights Primary School Year 4 Parent Planner: Summer 2 Week 7 Topic – End of Term

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Dear Parents/Carers,

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English	This week the children will continue to write and publish their explanation texts on Volcanoes. They will also be completing their end of year reading assessments. In addition, we will test the children on the Summer (2 nd half) of year 3 and 4 spelling words. We will send home the complete list of year 3 and 4 statutory words with the words highlighted that your child knows. Any words not highlighted, children will need to learn over the Summer. For those children with all or nearly all the words highlighted, we will send home the list of year 5 and 6 statutory words for them to start learning.
Maths	This week in Maths the children will be continuing with their revision on 'Statistics.' They will be solving comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in a range of graphical presentations including bar charts and tables.
Topic	In RE, the children will finish their work on religious pilgrimages. In Topic, the children will look at climate change and how it affects the polar regions, as well as preparing for a debate on climate change later in the week. The children really enjoyed the 'Soundscape Arts Project' on Friday. They built dens using materials from the environment. We will continue to talk about next year with the children as part of our transitional work.

Sadly, we will be saying goodbye to Miss Garces this week. She has been a wonderful teaching assistant in 4RR and we wish her all the best of luck for the future. 4RR will have a party on Wednesday afternoon to say goodbye to Miss Garces. The children in 4RR can bring in finger food to share for the party. Please could we ensure that food with nuts is not brought in.

The children will be emptying their trays later this week. Could they bring in a bag to carry their work home?
