Dear Parents/Carers,

This term our theme is **Superstructures**.

English	This week we will be completing spelling, grammar and reading assessments to demonstrate everything we have learnt this term. At the end of the week, we will be completing a 'short burst' write which will require us to think carefully about every word we write while include different literary devices in our work.
Mathematics	In maths this week, we will be looking at time durations and lines. We will be using clocks to calculate time durations before solving word problems. We will also be looking at and identifying perpendicular and parallel lines in shapes.
Topic	In DT, we will be designing, building and evaluating our own bridges. In science, we will be looking at the life cycle of a flowering plant and seed dispersal.

Violin and recorder lessons will continue on Wednesday. Instruments need to come into school as usual.

PE for Year 3 will continue to take place on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons. **It is essential that PE kits continue to come in on a Monday and go home on a Friday.** If your child comes home in their PE kit, please can you ensure it comes back in the next day (it doesn't need to be washed, just bagged up).
