

Reception

We've been talking about belonging to different groups and focused on families this week. We've been ordering numbers in Maths, learning new sounds as well as the tricky word 'the'. Mrs Rizvi and Miss Dawes set us a challenge this term '....to find a way to transport an acorn across a table'. Hmmmm... when we've done it we'll show you some photos.

Year 1

We've really enjoyed using the story of The Three Little Pigs to help us develop our writing in sentences. We've been learning how to use Numicon in Maths, sorting different materials in Science and found out so much about the Great Fire of London already.





Year 2

We're loving our Dragon topic and have spent some of this week learning about Wyverne dragons and how to write a non-chronological report about them. We're starting with appearance and habitat sections. We've been ordering numbers from smallest to biggest and comparing two and three digit numbers using (<>). We've really enjoyed using our new sketching techniques to draw our own dragon eyes and different mediums to colour them.

Year 3

We've had a right giggle writing our own version of Chapter 4 of 'There's a Pharoah In Our Bath' and tried really hard to add tension and excitement. We've used role play to explore how people lived and farmed through the different seasons in Ancient Egypt and are using different techniques and materials to create Egyptian portraits.

Year 4

As well as our incredible trip to Longridge we've worked hard to finish and publish our autobiographies and self-portraits. We've been solving problems in Maths using our knowledge of place value and learning about vertebrates and invertebrates in our topic of Habitats and Living Things. Here's Olivia's self-portrait!
