We continue to develop and grow as a Community and when I 'step back' and look at what we've achieved this year alone my jaw drops. As well as building on events, experiences and achievements from our previous 3 years this school has started swimming sessions for our KS2 children, run Bikeability sessions and developed a fantastic Bike Bus (thanks to Dawn Rosser). We've gained our ModeShift Stars Bronze Award and been nominated for a Pride of Reading Award as a result of our local charitable efforts. The children have had the opportunity to participate in so many Inter-School Sports Events and Festivals. Children in Years 2, 3 and 4 have participated in Football, Tag Rugby, Cricket and Hockey Festivals thanks to Chris Ellison and his team from Performance Sports. We've also taken part in the 5th Oxon Winter Series Cross Country races, the Caversham Inter-School Cross Country Competition, and were hugely successful in the Green Park Mini Mile winning many individual and team trophies. We've been delighted to develop our relationships with other schools and play fixtures in Football, Tag Rugby, Rounders and Cricket against The Hill, Cranford House and Caversham Prep.

We've continued to develop and enrich the curriculum for the children with a wide range of trips to different places and workshops and talks from visitors. These have included our first Residential experience to Longridge by our Year 4's, visits to Marwell Zoo, Lepe Country Park, Beach Field Trip, Winchester Science Centre, The Earth Trust, Thatcham Discovery Centre and Vicon.
