Year 3

This week in Maths we've been busy collecting data and using t his to create our own bar charts. We've also completed a hot task to demonstrate everything we've learnt during our statistics unit. We've been editing the stories we've written based on Stig of the Dump and in topic we started learning about the Roman Invasion and what heppened to the Celts towards the end of the Iron Age.

Year 4

This week we continued with our work in Science and carried out an investigation into the best material to use for soundproofing. We had to consider independent and dependent control variables. In English we've completed some fictional writing based on Roman myths and have been finishing our Google slide presentations, mosaics and Fishbourne Palace Leaflets. We can't wait for our Bikeability sessions to start.



Year 5

In English this week we've enjoyed writing poetry about Space and have focussed on imagery and description through senses. In Maths we have been looking exercise affects our heart rates and have been drawing line graphs based on our results. In our topic work we have made orreys to examine how the Moon orbits the Earth and also looking at the impact that tourism has on mountains.
