Reception

This week we've continued with our theme of Noah's Ark and have written pages for Noah's Log Book and instructions for building an Ark. We've enjoyed solving tricky 'Noah' problems in Maths, creating collage animals using animal print paper and designing a unique animal using Purple Mash. We learnt to throw the Nerf Rocket in Athletics and practised our High Jumping again.

Year 1

This week we've been learning how to read and write poetry by looking at animal poems, videos and books. We then wrote our own poems and some of them made Mrs Powell 'well up'. We thought we'd done something wrong! In History, we are investigating significant people who have played an important role with animals and have really enjoyed learning about Steve Backshall. We've learnt about the Human Body in Science and have been designing and making giant animals with junk modelling using what we learnt about different body parts.

In Science, we've been investigating which objects create the best shadows and why. We've been developing our batting and fielding skills in Cricket and are also enjoying our Athletics lessons.

It's been such a busy week for us! As Mrs Edwards mentioned earlier, 4CT made Scones and prepared and held a Cream Tea for parents after school on Wednesday.
