Dear Parents and Carers

We have had another busy, fun-packed week at The Heights. I just wish I could share all the amazing moments we've had with the children with you. They are always looking at how they can help or support each other or members of staff in the 'lunchbox' and their manners are wonderful. Their enthusiasm, curiosity and thirst for learning make them a joy to be with - so please hurry up and bring them back on Monday because we can't wait for next week!

Our Reception children have been continuing to focus on their theme of 'All About Me, All About Us'. They have been writing their names using different pens and pencils, crayons and paint. They have been learning to sort in

Maths and to use different indoor and outdoor environments. PE focused on the children moving in different ways and at different speeds in different directions.

This week Year 1 have been reading and reviewing The Tiger Who Came to Tea. They have been investigating the properties of 2D and 3D shapes and finding out about different materials around our school.



Year 2 have learnt where chocolate comes from and sequenced the process of how chocolate gets from the tree to the shops. We have been using atlases to research where cacao grows and innovating our 'Love Monster and the Chocolate' story. In Maths we've been looking at how unique they are and sketched and used watercolours to create self-portraits.
