Reception

In Reception we have been learning about and creating repeating and symmetrical patterns. We have learnt the story of Rama and Sita, made divas and drawn mehndi patterns on our hands and Rangoli patterns on the playground. We have talked about Remembrance Day and observed a minute's silence.



Year 1

In Year 1 we have concentrated on time this week. We learnt about o'clock and half past the hour and some of us can even tell when it's a quarter to or a quarter past the hour. We have made the most delicious coconut Diwali sweets, gorgeous lanterns and very creative poppy pictures.



Year 2
