I can't believe that we only have two more weeks before the end of this Autumn Term. Wow! They are going to be busy ones too as we all enjoy the build-up to Christmas. We are really looking forward to our Christmas Fayre tomorrow between 12 and 2.30. Thank you so much to the PTFA and you all as parents for the work you have already done in preparation. I'm looking forward to seeing many of you there.

We also cannot wait for our whole school trip to the pantomime 'Dick Whittington' at the Hexagon a week today. The coaches will be leaving at 9.15am so please can you ensure the children arrive at school by 8.45am to give us time for registration and checking everyone has everything they need.



Reception

This week in Reception we have been looking at the different houses we live in. We have been drawing fantasy houses, what we can see when we look out of the window and writing about the houses we live in. In Maths we have been learning to recognise tricky numbers so that we can fulfil our roles as postmen. We have been continuing to practice for our nativity productions and enjoyed the visit from the REInspired volunteers when we learned about the Christmas story and made King's crowns and candle holders.

Year 1

This week Year One have been busy with our Top Secret Project - thank you to all those parents who remembered to send in baked bean tins! We have been learning about and writing the Christmas story in English, and in Maths we have been investigating money and coin value. Next week we have a Father Christmas wrapping workshop so if you could send in some small boxes and Christmas wrapping paper we would be grateful. We have also spent lots of time practising for our Christmas Performance!

Year 2

This week in Year 2 we have spent a lot of time rehearsing our KS1 Christmas Nativity. We are really enjoying singing the songs and are working hard to remember our lines.

In Literacy, we have finished reading *The Chocolate Touch* story and we found the ending very exciting! We have mapped the story out and have been retelling it in our own words. Next we will use our story maps to write our own versions. We have been working on using question marks every time we write questions. We have been learning alternative pronunciations for letters.

In Guided Maths, we have been practising multiplication using "lots of" counters, cubes and pegs. We moved on to drawing arrays to help us calculate multiplication questions. Some children in the class also "shared" resources when dividing large numbers.

In Maths, we have been busy finding halves and quarters. We have learnt to halve numbers up to half of 30. We have been colouring a half and a quarter of shapes and we have moved on to finding half of objects. We even recognise that $\frac{2}{4}$ is the same as $\frac{1}{2}$.

In Creative Curriculum, we have been junk modelling and painting our Wonka's Chocolate Factory designs. We are really looking forward to taking them home with us today.
