Reception

We have started our new Topic - Journeys and will be looking at different journeys people make in all sorts of way locally, nationally and internationally. We have been learning to add numbers in Maths. We have learnt the story of the Bear Hunt and developed our own story, pictures and maps. We really enjoyed exploring different materials and creating our own textural maps too.

Year 1

We have been getting back into school after the holidays and have started to investigate place value in Maths and focussed on fantasy settings in our English lessons. We have started our new topic of Space and are really excited about all the things we have planned for the topic, particularly as we are following Tim Peake and his adventures.

We have brought in lots of things from home to share about and are enjoying our Dance lessons where we are currently pretending to be in podcasts.

Year 2

We have been thinking about our goals for the year ahead and setting targets for ourselves. We have written recounts of what we did over the Christmas holidays. We have learnt what suffixes are and recognise ways that they can change the meaning of words. In Maths we have been working on consolidating place value and ordering numbers. We have been using the > and < symbols and rounding to the nearest multiple of 10. We have started discussing our new topic - One World - and have written questions

we would like to explore this term and will be looking at creation stories from different world religions. In Dance we moved our bodies using the ocean as motivation.



Classteachers will be sending home their termly topic webs and newsletters on Monday. These will give you an overview of some of the different things the children will be exploring and learning about this term. Copies will also be posted on the website.
